In the spirit of Doug's philosophy - There's a time for competitive golf and there's a time for FUN golf. We've definitely mixed in a lot of fun but we completely understand if you are more traditional and want to play a traditional team scramble or only want to pick and choose from any of the below to take part in. We want you to truly enjoy your time on the golf course today and remember our friend fondly.

Below is an explanation of the very loose "rules" for the event. We will have some prizes & contests and due to the nature of the starting times and no formal post event gathering we will share the results electronically and be happy to ensure each team gets their prizes sent to them along with PHOTOS to share and will utilize our Family Cup webpage for that info!

All proceeds raised from this event will be put towards our PGA NENY Reach Foundation activity to start a collegiate scholarship fund for junior members eligible from our NENY PGA Junior Golf Association in Doug's name.

Our sincere thanks for giving of your time and supporting this initiative with us in the name of an incredible person to help *"positively impact lives through golf"* and we hope you tell others about it to help us grow this event each year!

Hole #1 - Traditional Long Drive Competition - Use the marker and write your name down for the longest drive.

NOTE that only a drive that lands IN THE FAIRWAY is eligible!

Hole #2 - Divot Derby - Before the first person on your team tees off, start a timer on your phone. As soon as the ball is holed stop the timer. You MUST pick up the balls you don't use! Be sure to record your team name and time on the marker located near the green

Hole #3 - 3 Club Challenge - All players on the team must decide AS A TEAM which 3 clubs to play the hole with.

Hole #4 - Closest to the Pin - Use the proximity marker and write your name down for the closest to the pin.

Hole #5 - Hidden Target - There are multiple hula hoop targets located on this fairway and approach. If your ball lands in one, be sure to record your name on the clipboard sheet near the green!

Hole #6 - Feather a Driver - We know this is a Par 3 but all players MUST hit a driver off the tee!

Hole #7 - Happy Gilmore - Yep, all players must do a "Happy Gilmore" and get a running start when you hit your drive off the tee.

Hole #8 - Drive a Marshmallow - All players on the team MUST hit a marshmallow for their tee shot! Select the best marshmallow shot and play from there. We suggest using the martini tees provided - but please leave them for others!

Hole #9 - Putt out With a Hockey Stick - After you've selected the ball on the green your team plans to hit you must give up your putters and putt the ball out with the hockey sticks provided!

Other Contests & Notes: Be sure to submit your guess for the # of tees in the trophy at check in and submit your answer to the Rules Question too! We will have a snack area located near holes #3, #4, and #5 and be sure to bring your smile for our team photo contest!
